An activity that is, or includes, the sale of goods or services directly to the general public.</p> | <p>Propose of activity is work-related, highly specialised and non-ongoing work.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do short-term, highly specialised, non-ongoing work • Participate in an event or events on a non-ongoing basis at the invitation of an Australian organisation. • In limited circumstances, participate in an activity or work relating to Australia’s interests. |
| Requirements | <p>Be outside Australia</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engage in business visitor activities • Invitation letter provided by organisation operating lawfully in Australia • Evidence of personal business background provided in accordance to the proposed business activity. | <p>Be outside Australia</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have specialised skills, knowledge or experience that can assist Australian business • Have been invited to participate in an event by an organisation operating lawfully in Australia • Are required in Australia for exceptional circumstances of national importance, such as to assist following a natural disaster. |
